

DESERT OF DEATH

Where is a simple yet effective Step by Step to use the Greenstuff World liquid pigments to obtain desertyc bases for gaming

1. Use of Black Matt Primer to basecoat the sandy zones of the base.





2. Apply a generous coat of Medium Earth liquid pigment, with no dilution, covering the whole black basecoat.





3. Once dry the first coat, apply now a second coat of Light Earth liquid pigment, barely diluted and again covering all the surface (the picture shows the wet pigment).

4. This is how will look like the second coat of liquid pigment when dry.

5. In some small areas of the base, apply some patches of Ochre Earth liquid pigment and "cleaning" the borders of each patch with water.

6. Aspect of the Ochre Earth when dry.

7. Now I paint the rest of the elements of the base (skull and metallic debris).

8. The final touch is to apply a pair of very thin glazes of highly diluted red paint (Hellfire Red) to all the base and elements on it, to get a common atmosphere.



And that's all:
