

ORANGE BRONZE

Another Step by Step using the Greenstuff World paints to test the main colors: this time i'll use Orange to get a bronze Non Metallic Metal finish.



1. Basecoat with Redwood Brown.



2. First highlight with a 50 % mix of Hellfire Red and Flaming Orange, covering most of the area.



3. Now highlight with a coat of Flaming Orange.



4. Add a 25% of Cyber Yellow to the Flaming Orange and keep highlighting the main upper areas.



5. Now add a bit of Golden Cream to the last mix (20% Golden Cream, 20% Cyber Yellow, 60% Flaming Orange, approximately) and highlight the edges and main light areas.

6. Add a bit of Fang White to the mix to outline the edges, rivets and put some tiny light points.

7. Give 2-3 general washes with highly diluted (80% water) Forest Green to the whole piece to add some extra contrast and darken the recesses.

8. Finally, with a couple of general washes with highly diluted Hellfire Red will recover the reddish tone of the bronze and soften the texture effects.
